#### **MINUTES**

#### TELLURIDE REGIONAL AIRPORT AUTHORITY BOARD MEETING

#### January 16, 2014 12:00 pm

1. Call to Order 12:05 pm

Chair Jon Dwight called the meeting of the Telluride Regional Airport Authority to order.

#### Roll Call

Present: Chair Jon Dwight, Vice Chair Ann Brady. Board Members Paul Talmey, Gary Bash, Matt Skinner, Stu Fraser, Kevin Jones, Joan May, Lynne Beck. Board Alternates Mick Francis, Michael Martelon, Mark Silversher.

Also present: Rich Nuttall (Airport Manager), Linda Soucie (Administrative Assistant), Bob Erie (Attorney), Clifford Hansen (Insurance of the San Juans).

Absent: none.

2. A. Approval of Minutes: December 19, 2013

#### Motion

Ann Brady motioned to approve the minutes of December 19, 2013. Stu Fraser seconded the motion.

Motion passed 9-0.

- B. Financial Report
  - 1. Approval of Accounts Payable

#### Motion

Stu Fraser motioned to approve the Accounts Receivable and Payables. Ann Brady seconded the motion. Motion passed 9-0.

- C. Chairman's Comments
  - 1. Planning Committee Update

John Dwight reported that the Planning Committee, based on the required Master Plan update with the FAA for 2014, and realizing that the business and financial model are driven by GA, that the Board should move forward toward a new GA terminal. There was discussion and Rich Nuttall was asked to present, at the next meeting, the major project components, the rough costs, and timing to move forward on the GA side.

2. Accounting Procedures & Policy Review

Jon Dwight reported that Checks that are being signed don't have the account assignment on the check. There was discussion about financial reports formats, changes to those reports, paper backup for the AIP checks, and fund (check) account assignment. The CPA (accountant) will be here 1/22 for a meeting. Paul Talmey, Ann Brady, Lynne Beck and Jon Dwight (call in) will attend.

#### 3. Marketing Committee Update

a. Airport Rebranding & Signage

Jon Dwight gave background on the rebranding plan that will be implemented this off-season (April). There was discussion on the plan and a licensing agreement. Jon Dwight directed the Marketing Committee (Matt Skinner and Michael Martelon) to come up with a marketing plan and budget for the 2/20/14 meeting.

b. 2014 Marketing & PR Plan

Matt Skinner went over the marketing plan that is already in place and gave an update on the new survey stations installed in the airport.

#### D. Noise Abatement

Nothing to report.

#### E. Colorado Flight Alliance Report

Matt Skinner reported that GLA has added an additional daily flight from Denver-Telluride-Kingman, AZ-LA. He gave an update on Horizon – too many diversions, so, no for now. Telluride Flights has asked for a letter stating that TEX can and will handle the capacity of their proposed additional flights. Jon Dwight will draft a generic letter.

#### 3. Airport Manager's Comments

A. Announcements and Updates

Rich Nuttall reported that the contract for the Wildlife Mitigation contract is ready to be signed.

#### Motion

Lynne Beck motioned to accept the Wildlife Mitigation contract.

Stu Fraser seconded the motion.

Motion passed 9-0.

Rich Nuttall gave an update on the status of the current grants.

AIP 28 (Slide remediation) – There will be a meeting with the contractor to discuss the contract time frame, the survey break on the project, liquidated damages, etc.

AIP 29 (Drainage and distance remaining signs) – The project will bid in 2-3 weeks. The grant is already in place.

AIP 30 (Design of the de-ice/run-up pad) — The project is 95% complete.

AIP 31 (Wildlife Mitigation) – The contract was just approved.

Master Plan update grant – The grant should be approved at the end of the month.

#### B. 2013/2014 Budget Update & Accounting Changes

Rich Nuttall reported that the 2013 profits were up because the expenses and operating costs were kept down. The 2013 Christmas operations were over 180, but fuel sales were static. The 2014 budget has been adjusted to reflect adjustments for insurance premium s and salary adjustments (3% per MSEC).

#### Motion

Paul Talmey motioned to amend the approved budget. Lynne Beck seconded the motion. Motion passed 9-0.

C. Review and Approval of Pollution Insurance Coverage and D&O Liability Insurance

Clifford Hansen presented the Pollution coverage and D&O Liability Insurance proposals. The 2/2014 renewal quote was discussed.

#### Motion

Paul Talmey motioned to approve the increase the D&O policy and accept the Pollution policy as it is presented in the proposal.

Ann Brady Seconded the motion.

Motion passed 9-0.

#### D. TRAA On-Airport Marijuana Policy

Rich Nuttall presented a resolution adopted by the Colorado Springs airport written to protect a federally funded airport from issues resulting from Marijuana potentially being transported on an aircraft. Bob Erie has reviewed the resolution and ran it by the SMC Attorney, Steve Zwick. Steve Zwick stated that TRAA has the right to impose such a resolution. The issue was tabled until the 2/20/14 meeting.

4. Announcements and Public Comments

Mark Silversher asked about the airport webcams. Rich Nuttall reported they are going to be ordered.

C. Executive Session: Personnel Review

#### Motion

Joan May motioned to adjourn to Executive Session to conduct a personnel review. Stu Fraser seconded the motion.

#### **Public Announcements**

#### **Grant Updates**

The following is an update regarding our FAA and State grants:

- AIP-28: The slide remediation project is completed. We will now begin the project close-out process.
- AIP-29: This project is currently being bid, and bids are due on March 6<sup>th</sup>.
- AIP-30: The design of the run-up/de-ice pad is 95% complete. Construction is not anticipated until 2015.
- AIP-31: The Wildlife Hazard Assessment has begun. This is a 12 month study.
- State Grant: A \$400,000 grant has been approved for the Master Plan Update.

  The board will need to approve and sign the grant at this meeting.

#### **Discussion Items**

#### Master Plan Update

The Airport Manager will review the Master Plan Update process and review the existing Terminal Area Layout and 6-Year Capital Improvement Project (CIP) objectives.

#### **On-Airport Marijuana Policy**

This discussion is a continuation from the January board meeting. Since that time, Denver, Colorado Springs, Aspen and Eagle Airports have implemented rules regarding Marijuana on their airports. How they deal with the disposal varies.
