TELLURIDE REGIONAL AIRPORT AUTHORITY BOARD MEETING

May 20, 2021 12:00 pm

1. Call to Order 12:03pm

Chair Mick Francis called the meeting of the Telluride Regional Airport Authority to order.

Roll Call

Present: Chair Mick Francis, Board Members, Matt Skinner (phone), Gary Bash, Richard Child (phone), Lynne Beck. Board Alternates, Tom Richards (phone), Denise Scanlon.

Also present: Kenny Maenpa (Airport Manager), Linda Soucie (Administrative Manager), Jason Currie (Operations Manager), Jessica Galbo (TAB).

Absent: Lars Carlson, Clifford Hansen, Banks Brown, Kris Holstrom. Board Alternate Mark Silversher.

- 2. Public Comments None
- 3. A. Approval of Minutes: March 18,2021

Motion

Gary Bash motioned to approve the March 18, 2021 minutes. Lynne Beck seconded the motion. Motion passed 7-0.

B. Chair Report – Mick Francis

Mick Francis read a letter that he drafted to be sent out to each TEX employee in appreciation of their hard work and dedication throughout the COVID pandemic. Each employee also received a \$250.00 end of season bonus. The TEX staff had a thank you card to present to the Board for their appreciation of the great support from the Board.

Mick noted that the June meeting will include a special event and the team from Tectonic will be here for the July meeting to give a presentation on the new hangar design.

C. Telluride AIDS Benefit – The Runway Fashion Show June 24th, 25th & 26th – Jessica Galbo, Executive Director Jessica Galbo gave a presentation detailing the plans for the annual TAB Fashion Show to be held at TEX 6/25 & 26/2021. There will be 2 VIP tables reserved for TRAA Board members for the Thursday show. The liquor license has been approved. Security will be by Vyanet. Seating will be in pods of 8 per table. There will be an auction. The event runs from 7:30 to 11pm nightly with the fashion show from 9-10pm. There will be an Andy Warhol art exhibit at the Madeline for VIP ticket holders.

Kenny Maenpa reminded everyone that the airport will be open until 9pm at the time of the event.

D. Budget

1. Ratification of Airport expenditures - Mar/Apr 2021

Motion

Tom Richards motioned to approve the Airport expenditures for Mar/Apr 2021. Gary Bash seconded the motion. Motion passed 7-0.

E. Committee Reports

- 1. Noise Abatement Kenny Maenpa There have been no noise complaints since the March meeting.
- 2. Planning Committee Mick Francis, Richard Child and Kenny Maenpa met today. They discussed the new hangar design, the EMAS system (TEX is the only airport with an EMAS system in the 7 western states), the SAF (Aspen has followed TEX in offering SAF) the CAOA Spring Conference being hosted by TEX (held at the Peaks 6/9-11/21, 120+ registered for the event). Mick noted that the Operating Budget is at 230% of the projection for the entire year.
- 3. Marketing Committee No meeting
- 4. Finance Committee No meeting

E. Colorado Flight Alliance Report

Matt Skinner reported DAC is operating 1 flight a day through the off season and summer. They ran a \$99 one-way fare this off season that was very popular and increased public awareness. DAC will possibly add an additional flight per day in July and are planning on 2 flight per day this winter season. CFA is still in conversations about a 2nd destination, additional aircraft, as well as an additional type of aircraft. Adding service into TEX is a high priority for CFA. There are also serious talks with 2 other airlines for the upcoming winter season. Summer 2021 bookings for DAC are looking solid. There was discussion regarding the recent Key Lime and Cirrus mid-air collision in Denver.

4. Airport Manager Report

Kenny Maenpa - Updates:

- Off season repairs The north tie-downs, short term parking lot and rental car return lanes have been paved and repainted.
- The runway and ramp pavement rehab (fog seal) has been rescheduled due to weather. A different (solvent based) material will be used to reduce application and curing times and keep the airport open for the DAC operations. The material will cost slightly more but will be offset by the CDOT grant.

A. New Hangar Design

Kenny Maenpa reported that the initial cost for the project is 13.5 million for a 30,000 square foot building. This will include 5000 sq. ft. on the north side for SRE storage, a lobby area, restrooms, potential space for offices, garage spaces, and a rental car wash bay. The design team will be here in June to meet with the SMC Building Dept., and TFPD. The investment partner agreements were originally ownership interest. The attorneys have been working on the agreement and there was discussion regarding the forming of an LLC, HOA board, etc. After review, and the involvement of a 2nd attorney, the agreements will be a "License Agreement" for space to store aircraft. The term will be 20 years. Kenny is planning on securing up to 8 licenses at 1.5 million each to raise the necessary capital for the Aircraft storage project. The SRE and horizontal development would be funded by TEX as an investment with a potential loan (up to 2 million). Kenny is planning on a briefing memo and license agreement for Board consideration at the July meeting.

Kenny met with the EMAS representative today for an inspection on the EMAS system. The rep. was pleased with the maintenance and had some products to recommend.

B. CAOA Spring Conference: June 9-11

The CAOA Spring Conference will be hosted by TEX June 9-11. The event will be at the Peaks. Kenny will send out email invitations for the Board to the plated dinner Thursday night at Alteza. Over \$70,000 has been raised in sponsorships for the event.

Denise Scanlon asked for an updated on the recent MCI (Mass Casualty Incident) exercise. Kenny explained that the live exercise is held every 3 years, with tabletop exercises in the in between years. This year, the mobile simulator was here for the ARFF training the entire week of 6/10. It was utilized for the MCI event on 5/12. Live victims were used and there were dummies inside the simulator. THE MCI was run in 2 stages. The 1st round was for the TEX staff, then as TFPD responded, the simulator fire was re-lit for a coresponse scenario. The event went extremely well. For the ARFF training held at TEX, firefighters from Moab,
